Named endowed scholarships honor those who have shown great dedication, commitment, outstanding achievement and service to the commercial real estate industry.

The CCIM San Antonio/South Texas Chapter is composed of CCIM Designees, Candidates, and Affiliate Members. Scholarship Description

Scholarships will be awarded to one Student and one Real Estate Professional each year, at a value of \$500 each. Applications will be evaluated by the Education Endowment committee of the San Antonio/South Texas CCIM Chapter.

Eligibility – Student Scholarship (*complete Student Application*)

One student of junior, senior or graduate standing will be awarded a cash award of \$500 to be used toward tuition or other educational expenses. The committee will give preference to applicants based on the following:

- Commitment to the Real Estate industry and the CCIM education
- Academic Achievement in Real Estate related course work
- Active involvement as a dues paying member with the San Antonio/South Texas CCIM Chapter
- Economic necessity

Eligibility – Real Estate Professional Scholarship (*complete Real Estate Professional Application*)

One real estate professional will be awarded a \$500 scholarship voucher to be used toward course registration for a CCIM Core Course (CI 101, CI 102, CI 103, CI 104) that is held in San Antonio. The committee will give preference to applicants based on the following:

- Active involvement as a dues paying member with the San Antonio/South Texas CCIM Chapter
- Commitment to a commercial real estate career
- Successful completion of prior CCIM courses and current Candidate Member of the CCIM Institute
- Economic necessity
